Securing Black futures requires ambitious, innovative, problem-solving that disrupts the status quo. This is why we work to enact policies and elect Black people and people who support Black communities to office--because we deserve to set the table, not just have a seat at the table. We need Black elected officials who represent our values, and transform those values into policies that lift us all. We need people representing us who don't just speak for themselves--we deserve elected officials who will bring us together to develop solutions to the challenges facing our communities, and who will fight to make those solutions the laws that govern us.
